Harvey Milk Civil Rights Academy is ready to kick off the 2024 Read-a-thon!

What IS Read-a-thon? First and foremost, it's a Celebration of Reading! For 10 days, students will be encouraged to read! Students will track and turn in their own minutes.

Secondly, in order to support the school's financial needs, **Read-a-thon is also a fundraiser** (though raising funds is NOT required to participate). Please encourage friends and family to support your reader!

Finally, Read-a-thon gives students the opportunity to **SET a goal, and then WORK toward that goal**. All students who meet or beat their goals will receive special recognition.

READ-A-THON TIMELINE

Before March 4:

SET A GOAL Go to <u>harveymilkpfc.org/readathon</u> to help your student set their goal for the number of minutes they can read in 10 days. A special prize given to ALL readers who set and MEET OR BEAT their goals.

Students can ask their families and friends to "sponsor" them as they work toward their goal. This is a great fundraiser to share with friends and family. Room parents will email helpful tips soon.

FIND SOMETHING TO READ

ALL reading counts: books they read, books students had read to them, comic books, reading for school, reading for fun.... All of it! There will be a school-wide book fair March 6-10 as well.


JOIN YOUR READERS!
